

FABRIC: *Farm Selfies* by Howard Robinson for Elizabeth's Studio LLC

1322 Cream (Panel): 24" x 44" panel

1323 Green (overall): 2/3 yard

355 Black (chicken wire): 1/3 yard

538 Green (Grass): 5/8 yard

Cream Solid: 3/4 yard

Black Solid: 1/2 yard

Backing for 32-1/2" x 40" quilt top

Batting for 32-1/2" x 40" quilt top

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

1322 Cream (Panel): From panel, fussy-cut large center panel to measure 23 x 15-1/2". Cut 4 smaller squares to measure 8" for corner blocks, centering motifs as desired.

1323 Green (overall): Cut (10) 4-1/4" squares, centering motifs as desired.

355 Black (chicken wire): Cut (2) 4-5/8" x WOF strips, crosscut into (10) 4-5/8" squares.

538 Green (Grass): Cut (2) 4-5/8" x WOF strips, crosscut into (10) 4-5/8" squares. Cut (4) 1-1/2" x WOF strips, crosscut into (2) 1-1/2" x 30-1/2" strips and (2) 1-1/2" x 40" strips for outer border.

Cream Solid: Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips, cross cut into (20) 2-1/2" x 4-1/4" strips and (20) 2-1/2" x 8-1/4" strips.

Black Solid: Cut (2) 1-1/2" x WOF strips, cross cut into (40) 1-1/2" squares. Cut (4) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, set aside for binding.

Constructing the Blocks:


SNOWBALL BLOCKS (10 blocks)



Place a 1-1/2" **Black Solid** square right sides together with a fussy cut 4-1/4" **1323 Green (Overall)** square. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the **Black Solid** square. Sew on the line. Trim **Black Solid** fabric 1/4" outside the sewn line. Press. Repeat to add a **Black Solid** triangle to each corner of the **1323 Green (Overall)** square. Make a total of 10 Snowball blocks.


ADDING CREAM TRIANGLES:

Sew a **Cream Solid** 2-1/2" x 4-1/4" strip to the top and bottom of a completed **1323 Green (Overall)/Black Solid** snowball block. Sew a 2-1/2" x 8-1/4" **Cream Solid** strip to each side of the snowball block. Trim the block to measure 5-7/8" - all blocks can have different slants (as shown in the quilt diagram), or can be the same as long as the block measures 5-7/8" square (including 1/4" seam allowance).




ADDING CHICKEN WIRE AND GRASS TRIANGLES:

Cut (10) 4-5/8" **538 Green (grass)** squares in half diagonally. Cut 5 in one direction and 5 in the other direction to maintain orientation of the grass (up and down).



Repeat steps with the (10) 4-5/8" **355 Black (chicken wire)** squares.

(The chicken wire fabric is not directional, so can be cut in either direction.)



Add 2 chicken wire triangles and 2 grass triangles to each of the snowball blocks, noting the placement of the chicken wire and grass triangles.

You should have :

(3) top blocks

And

(3) bottom blocks



And:

(2) left blocks)

And

(2) right blocks)



Assembling the Quilt:

Sew together the three top border blocks and add to the center panel. Sew together the three bottom border blocks and add to the center panel. Sew together the (2) left blocks and two of the fussy-cut 8" corner blocks. Add to the left side of the center panel. Sew together the (2) right blocks with two of the fussy-cut 8" corner blocks. Add to the right side of the center panel.

OUTER BORDER:

Add 1-1/2" x 30-1/2" **538 Green (Grass)** border strips to the sides of the quilt top. Add 1-1/2" x 40" **Grass** strips to the top and bottom.

FINISHING QUILT:

Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Use reserved 2-1/2" **Black Solid** strips to bind quilt.
