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FABRIC: *Good Old Days* by Abraham Hunter for Elizabeth's Studio LLC

9609 Black (panel)—2/3 yard

4314 Gray (bark)—1/4 yard

528 Lake (water)—5/8 yard

309 Multi (leaves)—1/4 yard

587 Light Cork—1/3 yard

587 Light Cork—3/8 yard for binding

Backing Fabric 1-1/4 yard

Batting for 31" x 31" quilt top

Cutting Instructions: (for one quilt)

9609 Black (panel): Fussy cut (2) 18-1/2" squares—only one is needed for the quilt, but by carefully placing the ruler all the way left and right on the landscape panel, you will have enough for 2 wall hangings if you wish.

4314 Gray (bark): Cut (2) 2" x WOF (width of fabric), cross cut into (24) 2" squares.

528 Lake (water): Cut (1) 6-1/2" x WOF, cross cut into (4) 6-1/2" squares. Cut (3) 2" x WOF, cross cut into (48) 2" squares. Cut (2) 2-3/8" x WOF, cross cut into (24) 2-3/8" squares.

309 Multi (leaves): Cut (3) 2" x WOF, cross cut into (48) 2" squares.

587 Light Cork: Cut (2) 2" x WOF, cross cut into (24) 2" squares. Cut (2) 2-3/8" x WOF, cross cut into (24) 2-3/8" squares.


587 Light Cork: Cut (4) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, set aside for binding.

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


Make Half-Square Triangle Units:




Place one 2-3/8" square **587 Light Cork** Right Sides Together with one 2-3/8" square **528 Lake (water)**. The "grain" of the water should be side to side. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the **587 Light Cork** square. Sew a scant 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut units apart on the drawn line, press to form (2) half-square triangle units. Repeat for a total of (12) sets to yield (24) half square triangles.




Make a second set of (12) squares—for this set, the "grain" of the water should still be side to side, but the diagonal line should be drawn in the opposite direction. You will have (24) half-square triangle units, opposite to the others.

Assemble Blocks:



Sew together (4) Half-Square triangle Units, (4) 2" squares **528 Lake (water)**, (2) **4314 Gray (bark)**, (2) **587 Light Cork** and (4) **309 Multi (leaves)** to form block. Be sure to orient the Bark fabric with the "grain" up and down and the Lake fabric with the water side to side.

Make a total of (6) of each configuration:



ASSEMBLE BLOCKS TO FORM BORDERS:

TOP BORDER:

Sew together (2) completed blocks of each configuration with (1) 6-1/2" **528 Lake (water)** block to form top border. Again, be mindful of the orientation of the lake and bark fabrics.




BOTTOM BORDER:

Repeat steps to form bottom border, arranging the blocks to follow diagram.




LEFT BORDER:

Complete left and right borders following diagrams at right.



RIGHT BORDER:



COMPLETING QUILT TOP:



Add left and right borders to fussy cut 18-1/2" **9609 Black (panel)** square.



Add top and bottom borders, maintaining the orientation of the blocks.

FINISHING:

Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired.

Use reserved 2-1/2" **587 Light Cork** binding strips to complete quilt.

Now that you are finished, use the second 18-1/2" square to make another quilt to keep or to give away!
