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FABRICS: *Animal Friends* by John Butler for Elizabeth's Studio LLC

7304 Blue Large Animal Print—3/4 yard
7304 Cream Large Animal Print—3/4 yard
F416 Light Blue Sparkle—5/8 yard
F416 Gold Sparkle—3/4 yard
231 Cream (Multi dots)—5/8 yard
F416 Light Blue Sparkle—1/2 yard for binding
Backing fabric—1-1/4 yards
Batting for 37" x 37" quilt top

CUTTING DIRECTIONS:

Large Animal Prints: Fussy-cut (13) 5" squares animal print with blue background, (12) 5" squares animal print with cream background, choosing and centering animal motifs as desired.

Lt. Blue Sparkle: Cut (6) 2-3/4" x WOF strips, cross cut into (48) 2-3/4 x 5" rectangles.

Gold Sparkle: Cut (8) 2-3/4" strips: and crosscut into (104) 2-3/4" squares.

231 Multi dot Cream: Cut (6) 2-3/4" strips, crosscut into (52) 2-3/4" squares AND (12) 2-3/4" x 5" rectangles.

Lt. Blue Sparkle binding fabric: Cut (5) 2-1/2" x width of fabric binding strips.

MAKING THE STAR POINT BLOCK:

Place one 2-3/4" gold square on 2-3/4 x 5" multi dot rectangle. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the gold fabric. Sew on the line. Trim 1/4" outside the sewn line. Press.



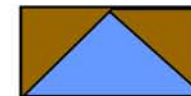
Repeat to add another gold square to the opposite corner.

You will need a total of:

(12) multi dot and gold



(40) blue and gold



(8) blue and multi dot



ASSEMBLING THE QUILT:

Following diagram for placement, sew star point blocks, remaining 36 multi dot squares and 25 animal blocks together to form rows, then sew rows together to form top.



FINISHING:

Layer with batting and backing fabric, quilt as desired. Use 2-1/2" binding strips to bind quilt.
