Fabrics: *Sunflowers by Elizabeth's Studio LLC*

Fabric Requirements	Sunset Colorway	Blue Sky Colorway
7/8 yard	591 Gold (panel)	590 Blue (panel)
1 yard	487 Yellow (sunflowers)	487 Yellow (sunflowers)
1-1/3 yards	559 Black (tone-on-tone)	559 Black (tone-on-tone)
1/2 yard	592 Gold (sunrise)	369 Blue (sky)
1/2 yard	559 Black (tone-on-tone) for binding	559 Black (tone-on-tone) for binding
4 yards	Backing fabric	Backing fabric

Cutting Directions:

Panel 591 Gold (sunrise) or 590 Blue (blue sky): Trim panel to measure 26-1/2" wide x 38-1/2" high.

487 Yellow (sunflowers):

Cut (4) 2-1/2" x WOF (width of fabric) strips.

Cut (6) 3-1/2" x WOF strips.

559 Black (tone-on-tone):

Cut (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, cross cut into (8) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" segments.

Cut (10) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, cross cut (4) of these into (2) 2-1-2" x 38-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 30-1/2" strips.

Cut (6) 1-1/2" x WOF strips.

592 Gold (sunrise) or 369 Blue (sky):

Cut (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, cross cut into (16) 6-1/2" x 2-1/2" segments.

559 Black (tone-on-tone): ut (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.



CONSTRUCTING THE QUILT TOP:



First Border (Black):

Add 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips **559 Black (tone-on-tone)** to sides of **591 Gold (panel)** or **590 Blue (panel)**.
Add 2-1/2" x 30-1/2" strips **559 Black (tone-on-tone)** to top and bottom of panel.

Second Border (Pieced):

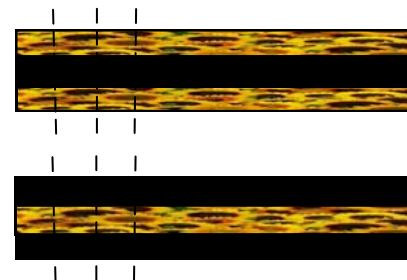
Sunflower Nine-patch blocks:

Sew (2) 2-1/2" strips **487 Yellow (sunflowers)** to (1) 2-1/2" **559 Black (tone-on-tone)** strip.
From this strip set, cut (14) 2-1/2" segments.

Sew (2) 2-1/2" strips **559 Black (tone-on-tone)** to (1) 2-1/2" strip **487 Yellow (sunflowers)**.
Repeat to make a second strip set. From these strip sets, cut (28) 2-1/2" segments.



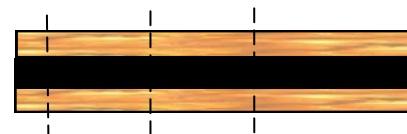
Sew together (2) black-sunflowers-black segments and (1) sunflowers-black-sunflowers segment to complete block.
Repeat to make a total of (14) Sunflower Nine-patch units.



Rail Fence Blocks:

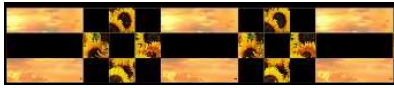


Sew together (2) 2-1/2" strips **592 Gold (sunrise)** or **369 Light Blue (sky)** and (1) 2-1/2" strip **559 Black (tone-on-tone)**. From the strip set, cut (6) 6-1/2" segments.
These are the TOP and BOTTOM Rail Fence blocks.



Sew together (2) 6-1/2" x 2-1/2" strips **592 Gold (sunrise)** or **369 Light Blue (sky)** and (1) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip **559 Black (tone-on-tone)** to create SIDE rail fence blocks. (This preserves the direction of the sunrise or sky fabrics).
Repeat to create a total of (8) SIDE Rail Fence blocks.

Completing Pieced border:



Sew together (3) TOP Rail Fence blocks and (2) Sunflower Nine-patch blocks to form top border. Sew in place. Repeat to complete bottom border and sew in place.

Sew together (5) Sunflower Nine-patch blocks and (4) SIDE Rail Fence blocks, maintaining the proper orientation of the Rail Fence blocks (sunrise or sky remains side to side in the block). Sew to side of quilt top. Repeat to create second pieced side border. Sew in place.

Fourth Border (Black):

Sew together (6) 1-1/2" **559 Black (tone-on-tone)** strips along short ends to form long strip. From this, cut (2) 1-1/2" x 54-1/2" side borders, sew in place. From remainder of strip, cut (2) 1-1/2" x 44-1/2" top and bottom borders. Sew in place.



Outer Border (Sunflowers):

Sew together (6) 3-1/2" strips **487 Yellow (sunflowers)** along short ends to form long strip. From this, cut (2) 3-1/2" x 56-1/2" side borders. Sew in place. From remainder of strip, cut (2) 3-1/2" x 50-1/2" top and bottom borders. Sew in place.

FINISHING THE QUILT:

Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired.
Use reserved 2-1/2" **559 Black (tone-on-tone)** strips to bind quilt.
